Dr Fernando Macário

Dr Macário holds an M.D. in nephrology and has broad experience in renal medicine and kidney transplantation, including basic and clinical research.

Dr Macário was instrumental in shaping Diaverum's clinical policies to ensure the protection of staff and patients against COVID-19. This included being a vocal advocate for vaccination, leading to a 80% rate of fully vaccinated clinical staff by the end of July 2021, which is on the frontline of industry standards.

Daniel Gallego is the president of the European Kidney Patient's Federation (EKPF). He has held the position since 2020; previously, he was the president of the ALCER Federation. In 2018, he launched booknowmed.com (a VC-backed start-up), offering renal patients treatment options across 400 dialysis clinics in over 50 countries worldwide. Booknowmed.com became part of Diaverum's portfolio in February 2021.

Since the acquisition, Aris has assumed a new role within Diaverum.
